



Sites in the September 1848 Cincinnati Panorama Daguerreotypes:

1. Coffee house, restaurant, and grocery of Joe Schierberg at #1 Cassily's Row, from 1848 to 1857. May have been part of his Uncle Sam's Corner business.
2. Northwest Corner Ludlow & Landing - Boatman's Hall boarding house, operated by Joe Schierberg & Bernard von Laer, from c.1845 to c.1848. Boatman's Hall existed until at least 1858 under other management. May also have been location of Fred Schierberg's boarding house from c.1839 to c.1845.
3. Northeast Corner Ludlow & Landing - Fred Schierberg's grocery store on which his name appears, and also his Jefferson House Hotel, both from 1847 to 1850. The Jefferson House continued in operation under other management until at least 1860. Fred's building was constructed in late 1847 to early 1848 and occupied the south half of his property. May also have been location of Fred Schierberg's boarding house from c.1839 to c.1845. Fred died in March 1852. Estate settled in July 1858 when Joe buys the property.
4. Northwest Corner Lawrence & Landing - Residence of Bernard and Elisabeth (Schierberg) von Laer - Owned February 1848 - June 1853; Elisabeth died there June 1851.
